

10. Press/Video clippings of the nominated Journalists shall be sent to the Judges well in time before the meeting of the Panel for their examination/study.

11. The judges shall take their decision on the basis of the objectivity and reliance on authentic sources of the publications/reports taking into account norms fixed by the Government.

12. The verdict of the judges shall be final and no objection or complaints will be entertained and no verdict shall be challenged in court.

13. If there is a tie for an award, i.e. if 2 or more Editors/Journalists are equally placed to be given an Award in the opinion of the Panel of Judges, decision shall be taken as follows :

i) The Editor/Journalist who has not received the Award shall be selected if all the others in the tie have received the Award in the past.

ii) If there are more than 1 (one) Editor/Journalist who have not received the Award, or if all the Editors/Journalists in the tie have received the Award in the past, selection shall be made from among them by draw of lots.

14. It is not mandatory that an Award shall necessarily be given in each subject/category in a year. If the Panel of Judges are of the opinion that no nomination for a category of the Awards is worthy of recommendation, they may refrain from doing so.

15. The awards will be given on the National Press Day, i.e. the 16th November.


